



Shopping List:

Unmounted British Wild Flowers & Meadow Flora A5 Stamp set, U-Mount Repositioning Mounting Cushion, Silver Mirri Card, Mixed Card Stock, Acetate & A3 Card Stock.

Cut 'n' Dry Foam, Cosmic Shimmer Clear Embossing Powder, Archival Jet Black Ink Pad, Alcohol Ink Applicator Tool & Adirondack Alcohol Inks – Stonewashed & Lettuce, Tim Holtz Distress Ink – Shabby Shutters.

Non-Stick Craft Sheet, Magnetic Sheet, Acrylic Block, 3D Glue, Double Sided Tape, Ribbon & Heat Gun.

Take the card that you distressed earlier and mat it onto a piece of blue card and attach a 12.5cm x 12.5cm folded light blue card using double sided tap.



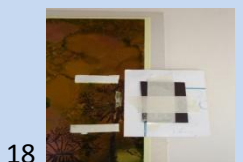

Make an insert to fit inside the folded blue card by trimming a folded piece of white light card. Stamp some flowers in the corners of the insert using the archival ink to add detail.

Place a piece of double sided tape to the front of the insert and attach in the card. Fold a piece of A3 card in half and trim to 25cm x 21cm to form the base card. Place the inked large panel onto the base card, then mat the sentiment and attach to the corner of the card.

Attach the magnet to the reverse of the topper securing with tape over the magnet so you don't block the force of the magnet with the tape. Then attach 2 pieces of foam tape directly onto the card, spaced within the size of the topper. The topper needs to be central to the folder card beside it.

Attach the topper to the foam tape, then take the flower and place the ribbon across the folded card and let the magnet attach to the flower topper.

Secure the ribbon down using double sided tape.



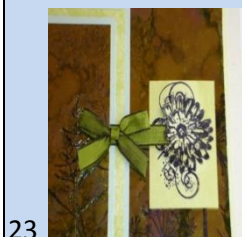

Cover the tape with the prepared small topper and add a bow to the side of the card.

This design will add interest to the front of the card and adding a different closure to the folded card

Stamp the small butterfly directly onto the card, then stamp and emboss the larger butterfly onto the heat embossable acetate, cut out fold the butterfly in half and attach to the card using clear glue.
